Application Requirements

To begin your journey at The Farm GSOM, please ensure that the following are submitted with your application:

- **Completed Application Form** (submitted online at www.thefarm.academy/apply)
- Non-refundable Admissions Fee: As stated in the current School fees structure
- Agreement to:
 - o Statement of Faith
 - Standards of Conduct
 - o Honorable Life Covenant
 - o Dress Code

When to Apply

We are currently accepting applications for the next intake. Any applications received after the posted deadline on our website will be considered for the following intake.

After You Apply

Once the Admissions Office receives all required documents and the non-refundable admissions fee, your application will be reviewed. Please allow up to 14 days for processing. As part of the application review process, a member of our team will contact you by email with more information on the next steps. This email will include a link to select a date for a one-on-one virtual clarity call. If you have any questions during this time, feel free to reach out to us using the contact information provided on our website or in the prospectus.



Statement of Faith

At The Farm GSOM, we uphold the following beliefs:

- God: We believe in one God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, Creator of all things.
- Jesus Christ: We believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, crucified, buried, resurrected, ascended, and seated at the right hand of the Father.
- **The Bible**: We believe the Bible is the inspired Word of God and the infallible rule of faith and conduct.
- Salvation: We believe in personal salvation through the blood of Jesus Christ.
- Sanctification: We believe in sanctification through the Word of God and the Holy Spirit.
- Healing: We believe in divine healing through faith in Jesus Christ.
- **Baptism**: We believe in water baptism, the Baptism of the Holy Spirit, and the gifts and fruits of the Spirit.
- The Return of Christ: We believe in the soon-coming return of Jesus Christ.

Standards of Conduct

The Farm is committed to maintaining an environment conducive to personal and spiritual growth. Students are expected to embody integrity and conduct that reflects excellence, consistent with the teachings of the Bible. Disciplinary actions will be taken for violations, ranging from verbal warnings to withdrawal from the program, as deemed appropriate by The Farm.

Behaviors That May Lead to Disciplinary Action

- Criminal activities, theft, fraud, dishonesty
- Use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco
- Immoral behaviors (e.g., fornication, pornography, sexual harassment of any kind)
- Engaging in fighting, harassment, or disorderly conduct
- Dishonesty in academic work (cheating, plagiarism)
- Excessive absenteeism or tardiness
- Failure to comply with The Farm's policies



Honor Life Covenant

Students must uphold the principles of personal integrity, honesty, and respect for God's authority in their life. The Honorable Life Covenant includes a commitment to:

- **Personal Integrity**: To live with an unwavering commitment to honesty and honor in all aspects of life, guided by biblical values.
- Honor and Obedience: To honor God-ordained authority in the family, society, and The Farm leadership. Students must submit to spiritual and governmental authorities, and demonstrate respect to fellow students, coaches, and staff.
- Active Spiritual Development: To live a life of purity, humility, and sanctification. Students will pursue spiritual growth, strive for holiness, and seek personal transformation through regular prayer, Bible study, and active participation in worship and community life.
- Integrity in Relationships: To maintain a life of purity and integrity in personal relationships. This includes a commitment to honor others, refrain from gossip, and foster an environment of trust and respect.
- **Commitment to Excellence**: To represent The Farm and Christ in all things with excellence, striving to do the right thing regardless of cost, living above reproach and exemplifying the Christian life in word and action.

This covenant is a guarantee that each student will live honorably before God and others, adhering to high moral standards and dedicating themselves to serving with integrity.

Financial Conduct and Lending Policy

The Farm Global School of Missions expressly prohibits any borrowing of money between students, as well as between students and coaches, or students and members of the administrative team. This includes all forms of loans, financial exchanges, or debt agreements.

While we deeply encourage a spirit of generosity and mutual care, it is important to note that assistance provided to others should be freely given of your own choice and not in the form of debt or repayment obligations. If you wish to help someone financially, please do so from a heart of generosity, willingly, and not as a loan. If financial assistance is required, please contact the welfare department, which will manage such matters appropriately.



Dress Code

Students are expected to present themselves in a manner that reflects respect for the Lord and others. This includes:

- **Modesty**: Clothing should be modest, clean, and appropriate for the occasion.
- **Neatness**: Students should maintain a neat and clean appearance at all times.
- **Prohibited Items**: Clothing that is revealing, immodest, or inappropriate for a respectful learning environment is prohibited. All attire should reflect a standard of decency, avoiding garments that may be considered disrespectful or distracting in the in person events or the residential campus.

Non-Discriminatory Policy

The Farm Global School of Missions admits students regardless of race, color, religion, nationality, or ethnic origin. We do not discriminate in the administration of educational policies, admissions, scholarships, or other school programs.

Refund Policy

- **Refund Eligibility**: No refunds are provided after the end of the second week of the academic year. If a student withdraws officially before this period, a refund will be issued minus an administrative fee equivalent to a one-month school fees installment according to the current rate outlined in the current school fees structure.
- After Second Week: No refunds will be issued after the second week of classes.
- **Expulsion**: If a student is expelled due to violations of the Standards of Conduct or the Honorable Life Covenant, no refund will be given.
